In the first six months of 2002 the ECC has received 241 queries with an estimated loss to Irish consumers of €300,000. The Spanish Police are currently investigating these Clubs and have jailed forty people for crimes such as fraud, extortion, grievous bodily harm, bribery of bank officials and more.

- **Don't believe everything you hear from Holiday Club representatives.**
- **Don't sign any documents until you have independent legal advice.**
- **If you join a Holiday Club you will not get value for your money.**
